Jeff Bezos: Billionaire makes first trip to space

1. _____

Jeff Bezos went into space in the spacecraft, New Shepard, accompanied by three other people - Mark Bezos, his brother, Wally Funk, an 82-year-old pioneer of the space race, and Oliver Daemen, an 18-year-old student. Ms. Funk became the oldest person to travel into space, and Oliver Daemen the youngest.

They travelled in a capsule which has the biggest windows flown in space. This meant the four passengers had stunning views of the Earth, even though the flight was not very long: the spacecraft lifted off at 14:12 (BST) and it lasted for ten minutes and ten seconds. Upon touching down, Jeff Bezos exclaimed: "Best day ever!"

3. _____

Two minutes into the flight, the capsule separated from its rocket and continued towards the Karman Line. The Karman line is recognized as a line dividing the Earth's atmosphere and the outer space, starting 100 kilometres from the sea level. After the flight, a video was shown of the passengers going up and down, during four minutes when they experienced zero gravity. Also, breath-taking views of the Earth could be seen outside. On the return to Earth, Jeff Bezos told mission control: "You have a very happy crew up here."

4. _____

The spacecraft, New Shepard, was built by Bezos's company Blue Origin. It is designed for the space tourism industry. Amazon founder Mr. Bezos - and other people in the 'billionaire space race' - have been criticised for offering what some see as joyrides for the richest people on Earth. Critics say the money could be spent in other ways – for example, on pay rises for employees or fighting climate change.

Mr. Bezos states that he has an environmental vision: "We need to take all heavy industry, all polluting industry and move it into space, and keep Earth as this beautiful jewel of a planet that it is," he told MSNBC. "It's going to take decades and decades to achieve, but you have to start, and big things start with small steps... that's what this tourism into the orbit allows us to do, it allows us to practice over and over."
